
Dear Mr. Stanley:

Please be advised that based upon the representations set forth in your letter and since Calvary Chapel is not a candidate for political office or a registered political action committee/campaign committee, Section 12.48.030.A. (deposit requirement) of the Chino Hills Municipal Code is not applicable to your client or the recipients of the signs.
