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23 THIS MATTER came before the Court upon the parties' agreement to the  
 24 entry of a Stipulated Permanent Injunction. Plaintiffs submitted the proposed Sti-  
 25 pulated Permanent Injunction (Doc. # 96) on November 5, 2008. Defendants were

1 permitted an opportunity to submit any objections to the proposed Stipulated Per-  
2 manent Injunction by November 10, 2008. Having received no objections from  
3 Defendants, this Court is prepared to enter the Stipulated Permanent Injunction.  
4  
5 The Court, having reviewed the Plaintiffs' Notice of Filing Proposed Stipulated  
6 Permanent Injunction (Doc. # 96), and noting the Defendants have not submitted  
7 any objections, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, hereby OR-  
8  
9 DERS AND ADJUDGES as follows:

- 10 1. The following Stipulated Permanent Injunction is **GRANTED**.
- 11 2. The terms and conditions are set forth as follows:
  - 12 1. All persons and entities, their agents, employees, repre-  
13 sentatives, and all persons acting in concert, or participat-  
14 ing with them, are hereby restrained and enjoined from  
15 distributing literature and/or conversing with the general  
16 public (a) within ten (10) yards of the ticketed access on-  
17 ly gated entrance(s) to any Israeli Independence Day Fes-  
18 tival, and (b) inside of the fenced area separating the  
19 ticketed access only Israeli Independence Day Festival  
20 from the remainder of Woodley Park (or any other park  
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1 facility if the event location is moved from Woodley  
2 Park).

3 2. The City of Los Angeles, its officers, agents, employees,  
4 representatives, and all persons acting in concert, or par-  
5 ticipating with them, are hereby restrained and enjoined  
6 from engaging directly or indirectly in any act that would  
7 result in the harassment, arrest and/or detention of Plain-  
8 tiffs or any other person or entity, or otherwise restricting  
9 Plaintiffs' or any other person or entities' right to distrib-  
10 ute literature and/or converse with the general public in  
11 any area of Woodley Park (or any other park facility if  
12 the event location is moved from Woodley Park) which is  
13 (a) greater than ten (10) yards from any Israeli Independ-  
14 ence Day Festival's ticketed access only gated en-  
15 trance(s), and (b) outside of the fenced area separating  
16 the ticketed access only Israeli Independence Day Festi-

5 4. The City of Los Angeles, its officers, agents, employees,

9 Festival for the purpose of informing the Festival organ-  
10 izers of the terms of this Stipulated Permanent Injunction,  
11 the boundaries of any Israeli Independence Day Festival,  
12 and that Plaintiffs' or any other person or entities' First  
13 Amendment rights to distribute literature and/or converse  
14 with the general public in any area of Woodley Park (or  
15 any other park facility if the event location is moved  
16 from Woodley Park) which is (a) greater than ten (10)  
17 yards from any Israeli Independence Day Festival's tick-  
18 eted access only gated entrances, and (b) outside of the  
19 fenced area separating the ticketed access only Israeli  
20 Independence Day Festival from the remainder of Wood-
