AGREED ORDER OF SETTLEMENT

Plaintiff filed its Verified Complaint on October 2, 2006 and filed a motion for preliminary injunction on October 16, 2006. On November 13, 2006, this Court granted Plaintiff's and Defendants' Stipulated Preliminary Injunction, which enjoined Defendants from

enforcing each of the following in any manner that would prevent Plaintiff from using religious criteria to select group leaders or to formulate religiously-based rules of conduct for those leaders:

- University of Wisconsin System Regent Policy number 88-12 contained in University of Wisconsin System Regent Policy Documents. (Mot. for Prelim. Inj. (MPI) Ex. F at 29–31.)
- The nondiscrimination policy contained in the University of Wisconsin-Superior 2005–2006 Student Handbook. (MPI Ex. D at 17, 19–22; MPI Ex. G at 34, 42–43; MPI Ex. H. at 51.)

(Order, Nov. 13, 2006.)

Since the Court granted this stipulated injunction, Plaintiff and Defendants have entered into the Settlement Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and have agreed to the following Agreed Order of Settlement:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED THAT:

1. Defendants shall declare that Plaintiff's constitution, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, is fully compliant with all existing University of Wisconsin-Superior criteria for official recognition and all existing University of Wisconsin System nondiscrimination policies, including the Board of Regents' Resolution 9279, adopted in December 2006.


2. Defendants shall provide Plaintiff with a student activity fee award for the 2006–07 school year by awarding Plaintiff \$1564.33, an amount equal to the average of the student fee allocations Plaintiff received for the 2003–04, 2004–05, and 2005–06 school years. This payment shall be made within 30 days from the entry of this Order.

3. Defendants shall pay attorneys' fees and costs in an amount of \$20,000.00. This payment shall be made within 30 days from the entry of this Order.

Pursuant to this order, Plaintiff's Verified Complaint shall be dismissed with prejudice, with each party bearing its own costs and expenses except as indicated above.


